2. **Kanji reading** (7 marks)

3. **Choose the correct particle** (7 marks)

4. **Choose the correct word** (7 marks)

5. **Choose the correct sentence order** (7 marks)

6. **Comprehensive questions(reading)** (12 marks)

*marks in each section may have a minor change

For Term end Written Examination, there will be 50 points. Each point will have average score of 0.4, so that the maximum score in written exam will be 20 only. It is compulsory to appear in the final written and oral exams to be eligible for the certificate.
