Practice Teaching

- At least 10days should be taken for practice in a school (Class V to X) nearby the study centre.
- Out of all the units, one unit should be finally selected by the learner and presented before the supervisor
- The supervisor will assess the performance of the learners on the basis of the units prescribed in the paper

The supervisor should be at least an Associate Professor of the study centre, near by study centre or from any recognized institution
